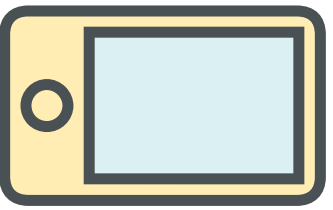

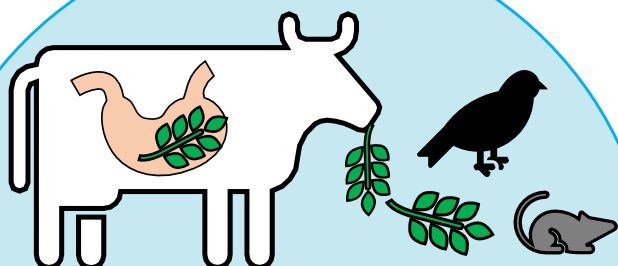

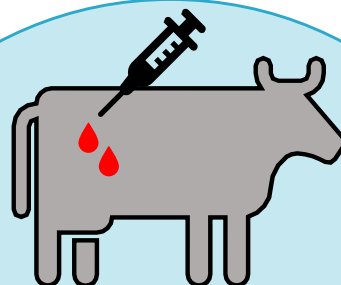


# How are diseases transmitted?



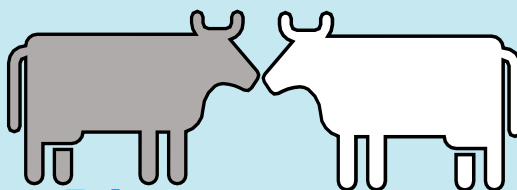
## Oral transmission

Normally by swallowing the pathogen with contaminated feed or water.



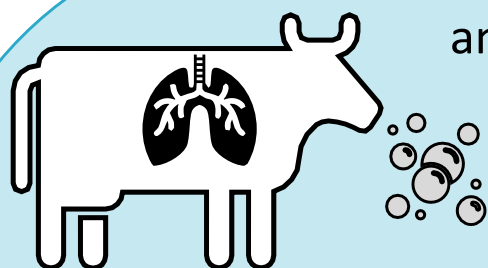
## Blood transmission

Blood transmission via, for example, used syringes contaminated with infected blood.



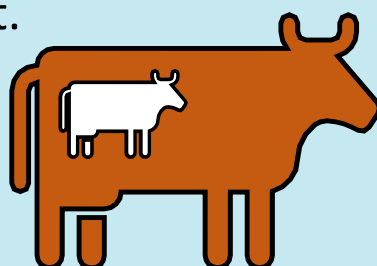
## Direct contact

Direct contact, for example, between two animals or an animal and the environment.



## Airborne

By inhaling the pathogen into their lungs.

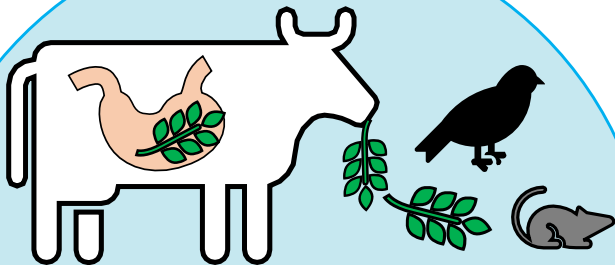


## Reproductive organs

Transmission via artificial insemination, mating or from a cow to a fetus.

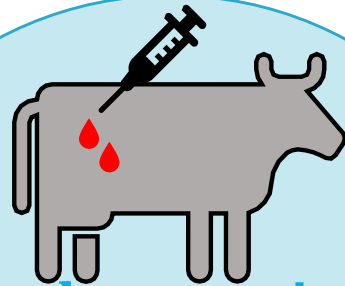

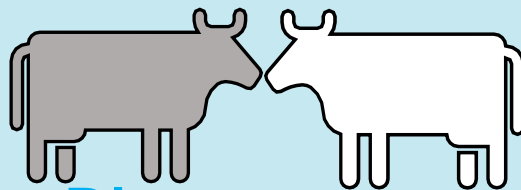
## Oral transmission

Normally by swallowing the pathogen with contaminated feed or water.



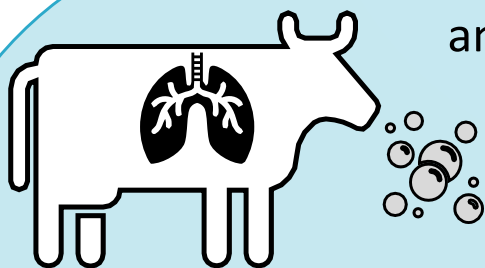
## Blood transmission

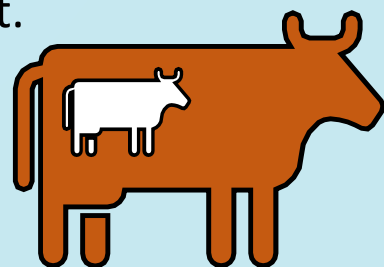
## Direct contact
